THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (TRAFFIC REGULATION)

(MAYROYD LANE, HEBDEN BRIDGE) (NO. *) ORDER 20**

The Borough Council of Calderdale in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

<u> PART 1</u>

GENERAL

Citation and commencement

 This Order is made on the ** day of **** 20** and shall be cited as "The Borough Council of Calderdale (Traffic Regulation) (Mayroyd Lane, Hebden Bridge) (No. *) Order 20**" and shall come into force on ** **** 20**.

Interpretation

- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Where a provision of this Order is in conflict with a provision contained in a previous order, the provisions of this Order shall prevail for the period that this Order is in force.
- 4. Where a statute, statutory instrument, specification or regulation is referred to such reference shall include an amendment to or replacement thereof.
- 5. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, regulation or other requirement imposed by law.

Definitions

6. In this Order, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"Council" means the Borough Council of Calderdale and includes any contractors or authorised agents appointed by or acting on behalf of the Council for the purposes of any function under the provisions of this Order; "Invalid Carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 20 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970;

"Motor Vehicle" has the same meaning as that in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"Pedal Cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedue 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

"Road" has the same meaning as that in Section 142 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"Undertaker" has the same meaning as that in Section 48 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991;

"Wheelchair" means an invalid wheelchair or carriage propelled by hand.

PART 2 PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

- 7. Save as hereinafter provided, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in the length of Road specified in the Schedule to this Order provided that for the avoidance of any doubt this Order shall not apply to a vehicle that is an Invalid Carriage, Wheelchair, perambulator, handcart or a Pedal Cycle.
- 8. The Council is satisfied that for the purposes of avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road to which the Order relates and for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising it is requisite that section 3(1) of the Act of 1984 shall not apply to this Order.
