Calderdale Safe Place Scheme

What is it?

The scheme helps those with learning disabilities and aids other vulnerable people to be supported when they experience any incident that takes place whilst they are out and about in the borough.



The incidents could range from someone requiring directions, someone who has lost their wallet/purse or they may have been the target of harassment or bullying.

How does it work?

If a person needs assistance, all they have to do is show their Safe Place card, or if they do not have one, speak to a member of staff who will offer support and contact the people listed on the card.

Safe Place centres will display a poster promoting the scheme and are located across the borough including Halifax bus station, libraries, leisure centres, supermarkets, medical practices and community hubs across Calderdale.
