## POST STAGE 2 MIQ SCHEDULE OF MINOR BOUNDARY CHANGES TO GREEN BELT PAPER

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The production of this paper has been necessitated following receipt of the Inspectors Pre-hearing Questions for Stage 2 of the Examination into the Calderdale Local Plan dated 27 May 2020. The questions contained a number of queries primarily relating to matters due to be covered by the Stage 2 hearings. Specifically, the 2 questions detailed below raise issue with the robustness of the Green Belt boundary and the possible need for coincidental changes to the Green Belt following the allocation of sites LP1409 and LP1618 for development:

Matter 13: Site LP1618 – Land west of Huddersfield Road, Brighouse question d): If the site is released from the Green Belt, is the Council satisfied that the remaining Green Belt boundary between the site and housing allocation LP1451 would be robust? Or are consequential changes needed to the Green Belt in this locality?

Matter 18: Site LP1409 – e): The proposed amendment to the Green Belt boundary would result in Green Belt to the north and north-east of the site being surrounded by built development. Would consequential Green Belt changes be necessary in these locations?

Whilst the Council performed a tidy up exercise of the Green Belt prior to the submission of the Local plan, the results of which are detailed in the Schedule of Minor Boundary Changes to Green Belt Paper (CC48), a number of new sites have been added to the Local Plan since this time resulting in further Green Belt anomalies or irregularities. The Council has therefore carried out a further tidy up exercise of the Green Belt to include the queries raised by the Inspector regarding the robustness of the Green Belt boundary in close proximity to sites LP1451 and LP1618 and the additional sites added to the Local Plan.

The results of this exercise are documented in this paper and should be read in context with the Council's Technical Paper on Exceptional Circumstances for the release of Green Belt (EV09) and its addendum (CC38); Schedule of Minor Boundary Changes to the Green Belt (CC48); Chapter 19 of the Calderdale Local Plan and relevant MIQ answers concerning the Green Belt (Examination Hearing Statements HS12 – HS20).

Each location where consequential Green Belt changes have been identified is shown on the accompanying maps with a detailed justification provided in Table 1: Green Belt Boundary Changes.
