

## CALDERDALE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL ADOPTION STATEMENT

## Notice of the adoption of the Calderdale Local Plan 2018/19 to 2032/33 in accordance with

## The Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) The Town and County Planning Act (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulations 17, 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), and Regulation 16 of the Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004, that Calderdale Council formally adopted its Local Plan on 22 March 2023.

The Calderdale Local Plan sets out the Council's spatial vision, strategic objectives and spatial strategy, strategic and detailed policies for development management up to 2032/33. The Local Plan replaces the Replacement Calderdale Unitary Development Plan (2006, as amended by Secretary of State, 2009).

The Local Plan was the subject of an independent examination conducted by a Planning Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The Inspector's Report was published on 27<sup>th</sup> January 2023 and recommended Main Modifications have been included in the adopted Local Plan which now carries full weight in the consideration of planning applications.

Any person aggrieved by the Calderdale Local Plan may make an application under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 to the High Court on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application to the High Court must be made not later than the end of the period of six weeks beginning with the day after the date on which the Calderdale Local Plan 2018/19 to 2032/33 was adopted.

A copy of this Adoption Statement will be sent to all parties who have asked to be notified of the adoption of the Calderdale Local Plan and to the Secretary of State for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities.
