CALDERDALE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK STRATEGIC HOUSING LAND AVAILABILITY ASSESSMENT

As you may be aware Calderdale Council is currently preparing its Local Development Framework (LDF) which will eventually replace the Replacement Calderdale Unitary Development Plan (RCUDP). In order to have a robust evidence base a number of studies are underway. One of these is a Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment (SHLAA), the purpose of which is to demonstrate that the Council has identified a five year supply of land for housing development and also to provide a pool of sites to consider for allocation in the LDF.

The SHLAA must include an assessment of whether sites are developable and deliverable as opposed to simply identifying sufficient land to meet the district's housing requirement. Since not all planning permissions are usually implemented it is important that only those likely to actually contribute to the supply of housing are included in the assessment.

The Council is therefore contacting all landowners/developers who have had planning permission for residential development for more than 2 years (as at the end of September 2008) and where development has yet to commence. Our records indicate that the following planning permission falls within this category:
