



**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (MILE CROSS TERRACE) (HALIFAX)
EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Calderdale ('the Council') under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') made the above experimental Order on 6th September 2023 the general effect of which is to introduce the following restriction on Mile Cross Terrace, Halifax, to operate at all times:

No motor vehicles shall proceed along its length from a point 50 metres south of its junction with the projected southern kerb line of Mile Cross Road for a distance of 1 metre.

The Order comes into force on 14th September 2023 for a period not exceeding 18 months.

Copies of the experimental order together with a map showing the affected roads and the Statement of Reasons for its making are available for inspection at Halifax Central Library, Halifax, HX1 1QG, from 10.00am to 5.30pm on Mondays to Fridays and 10.00am to 4.00pm on Saturdays. They are also on the Council's website at <https://new.calderdale.gov.uk/streets-and-transport/transport-initiatives/tro/current-tros> . Alternatively, copies of the relevant documents can be requested via email proposedtro@calderdale.gov.uk or by telephone 01422 288001 or 288002.

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Any person wishing to object to such indefinite continuation of the provisions may do so in writing within a period of six months from 14th September 2023 (i.e. by 14th March 2024), or if the Order is varied by another Order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the Act, within six months from the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made and be sent to either proposedtro@calderdale.gov.uk or to Highways and Transportation, C/O the Town Hall, Crossley Street, Halifax, HX1 1UJ for the attention of the Highways Traffic Team.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the experimental Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made (i.e. from 6th September 2023), apply to the High Court for that purpose.
